Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.165 dated 4.10.2022 registered under Sections 420, 406 IPC at Police Station Division No.4, District Patiala.

The allegations in brief are that the car in question was registered in the name of Jagdeep Singh son of the complainant and he sold the same to the petitioner but the petitioner failed to make payment of part of the sale consideration and in the meantime, said Jagdeep Singh went abroad but the balance payment was not made by the petitioner and ultimately, present FIR is lodged by the father of Jagdeep Singh.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and actually, entire amount with regard to sale of car was paid to Jagdeep Singh before he left for foreign country and in this regard, Jagdeep Singh gave in writing document Annexure P-4. He

further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the

police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Satvir Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and that the entire case is based on documents which are available with the police and now the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 11.11.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
