The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.121, dated 16.10.2022, under Section 66(D) of Information Technology Act, 2009 and Sections 384/419 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 14.11.2022, the petitioner was granted the interim protection.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, 415, Barnala, submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.11.2022, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 14.11.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.
