1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 176 dated 26.10.2022 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 IPC, at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.
2. Vide order dated 22.11.2022, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 22.11.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that the matter has also been compromised between the parties on 30.08.2023.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Goverdhan Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.
6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 22.11.2022 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
