The petitioner herein seeks the quashing of the FIR bearing No.42 dated 19.06.2023 registered at Police Station Women, District Bathinda, under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, along-with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Mr. Virat Rana, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh from the afore-referred Police Station, he informs the Court that the investigation is still continuing and thus, the Challan has not yet been presented in the Competent Court, in connection with the criminal case under reference.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to

withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while submitting that if there need be, the petitioner would move a fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as claimed in this petition, at the appropriate stage, i.e after the conclusion of the investigation proceedings.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
