JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to consider medical bills of the petitioner.
2. Mr. Vivek Singla, Advocate who on advance notice is present in Court, at the outset, submits that respondent vide communication dated 02.06.2022 has rejected claim of the petitioner.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Vivek Singla agrees that if petitioner files fresh representation alongwith requisite documents, the Competent Authority would look into the matter and pass an appropriate order.
4. The petitioner is at liberty to file an appropriate

representation which would be considered and disposed of by Competent Authority in accordance with law. The Competent Authority shall decide representation of the petitioner within 4 weeks from the date of its filing.
