SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail in FIR No.108, dated 11.03.2022, registered at Police Station Siwani. District Bhiwani, under Sections 120-B, 201, 419, 420, 467, 468 & 471 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has undergone actual custody in excess of 06 months. There is no other criminal case pending against him. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as 11 Pws still remain to be examined. Other co-accused have been granted regular bail and thus, the petitioner may also be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 19.01.2023 digitally signed by Sh.Rai Sahab, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Bhiwani has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 06 months and 16 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that 11 Pws remain to be examined and that other co-accused have been granted regular bail.

Keeping in view the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and that similarly situated co-accused have been granted regular bail, I deem it appropriate to grant the same concession to the petitioner also. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
