RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for violating the order dated 25.11.1999 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.12492 of 1999.

A perusal of the record shows that the petitioner had already been given the land, way back in the year 2000, as per the order passed by the Court. The possession was also handed over to the petitioner. Not only that, learned State counsel has referred to the reply filed by the State, wherein it is stated that the petitioner has even further sold about 50% of the land out of the total land which was taken by her. Moreover, the present petition has been filed after about 23 years of the allotment of the land to the petitioner. This also dissuade the Court from continuing with the present petition.

In view of the above, there is no ground to proceed further in the contempt. Hence, the same is dismissed.

However, if the petitioner is having any further grievance qua the land allotted to her, she would be at liberty to raise her grievance before the appropriate Forum in appropriate proceedings.
