Status report by way of an affidavit of Dr. Darpan Ahluwalia, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Derabassi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) on behalf of respondent-State has been filed and same is taken on record.

2. On 07.10.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.130, dated 01.09.2023, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 472 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station Lalru, District SAS Nagar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the impugned sale deed was executed way back in the year 2011 and the present FIR has been lodged in the year 2023. The case is dependent upon the documentary evidence. It is also the contention of counsel for the petitioner that sale deed bears the signatures of the father of the complainant.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Vipul Dharmani, Advocate has appeared and filed Power of Attorney on behalf of the complainant. Copy of paper book be supplied to them during the course of day.

Adjourned to 04.12.2023 for filing status report.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to join investigation and co-operate in the same. He will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court nor shall make any attempt to contact the complainant of the case or any witness associated with the case. In the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Today, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 07.10.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 07.10.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
