1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have approached this Court for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect her life from private respondents No.4 to 9 as petitioners are in a live-in-relationship.
2. Heard counsel for the petitioners.
3. Concededly, petitioner No.1 is married to respondent No.4, though the relationship between them is strained and she is living with petitioner No.2. Relationship between the petitioners is illegal as well as immoral. This Court has no intention of putting its seal of approval on such a relationship.
4. Petition is dismissed.
