1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to extend the parole period of the petitioner by two weeks on medical grounds.
2. Status report filed by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, SDPO Central, Union Territory, Chandigarh on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2, is taken on record.
2. The petitioner was granted parole at the instance of the order dated 11.08.2023 upto 03.10.2023. The extension of parole has been sought on the score that the petitioner was suffering from dengue and admitted in hospital.
3. Learned Addl. Public Prosecutor, U.T., Chandigarh has not disputed this aspect of the matter. However, it has been pointed out that the extension of parole has been sought by a period of two weeks which has expired on 17.10.2023.

4. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that reasonable time may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the jail authorities.

5. In these set of circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the period of parole granted to the petitioner is extended upto 19.10.2023 and he shall surrender before the jail authorities on 20.10.2023.
