The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.93 dated 27.03.2014 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, has submitted that he does not press the present petition. Therefore, the same be dismissed as withdrawn. However, since the matter pertains to the year 2014, therefore, the trial Court be directed to complete the trial in a time bound frame. The petitioner shall not seek any exemption to delay the trial, as such.

Even, learned counsel for the complainant, who has come present in the Court, has no objection, if the trial is expedited.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the trial Court concerned is directed to make earnest efforts to complete the trial expeditiously, possibly within a period of one year from the date next fixed before the trial Court.
