1. The petitioners are living in a live-in relationship and have sought protection from this Court to protect their life and liberty.
2. Para 14 of the petition reveals that both the petitioners are earlier married. Petitioner No.1 is having two children from her earlier marriage who are presently living with her husband. Petitioner No.2 is also earlier married.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners could not convince this Court as to how and in what manner petitioners are feeling threats to their life and liberty from the private respondents, who are their family members besides respective spouses of both the petitioners. It appears that present petition has been filed just to put stamp of this Court to justify the illicit relationship of both the petitioners, without there being any threat perception.
4. Dismissed.
