AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.5

There are three claimants who suffered injuries in one and the same accident but have filed the common claim petition before the Tribunal and that is how a common appeal is before us.

The matter stands settled with separate proposal acceptance. The appeal stands settled at Rs.70,000/-, 40,000/- and Rs.35,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal in terms of consent form dated 22.11.2023 duly signed by both the parties.

Accordingly, this award is made with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the enhanced amount of Rs.70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand Only) by cheque/draft, in favour of appellant No.1-Amit Verma, Rs.40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand Only) in favour of appellant No.2-Prince @ Hanu Verma and Rs.35,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand Only) in favour of appellant No.3-Siya Verma with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 12.01.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopies of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of in terms of the settlement.
