It is stated by counsel for both the sides that matter has since been settled in the Mediation Centre. As per settlement, an amount of ₹25,00,000/- is required to be paid by the petitioner to the complainant- Kulbir Singh out of which an amount of ₹5,00,000/- has already been paid by way of Demand Draft, in compliance of the order dated 03.10.2023. It is further stated by counsel for both the sides that remaining amount of ₹20,00,000/- is to be paid in two installments of ₹10,00,000/- each payable by the end of December, 2023 and 15th March, 2024.

In view of the aforesaid admitted position, the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is allowed.

It is directed that in the event of the arrest of the petitioner, he shall be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer on furnishing requisite bonds.

However, it is directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
