Petitioner has challenged order dated 19.09.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Special Court, Ludhiana, whereby his bail has been cancelled in case FIR No. 35 dated 08.03.2022 under Section 21 NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna.

Learned counsel submits that petitioner was on bail. However, due to some unavoidable circumstances, petitioner could not appear on 19.09.2023 due to which his bail was cancelled and warrants of arrest have been issued against him. Learned counsel further submits that petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the trial court.

Present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial court within a period of 15 days from today. On his such surrender, the trial Court will initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C. On the disposal of those proceedings, petitioner shall be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial court concerned. Till the disposal of those proceedings, petitioner shall not be taken into custody. If in the

meantime, the petitioner is sought to be arrested on account of warrants of arrest having been issued against him, he shall be admitted to interim bail to satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Disposed of accordingly.
