Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner and take appropriate legal action against the private respondents.

Notice was issued by this Court vide order dated 18.10.2019.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, has submitted that the representation filed by the petitioner was duly considered. He submits that in the accident occurred the proceedings 174 Cr.P.C. were carried out and the postmortem of the deceased husband of the petitioner was also conducted. It is submitted that no foul play was found in the enquiry conducted and it was found to be a case of accident. He submits that three months after the incident, the present complaint was filed and the Investigating Agency found no foul play in the same.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this Court finds that basically it was an accidental case as submitted by learned State counsel, however, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to seek her remedy as available under the law.
