Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.1 to decide the petitioner/ROR NO.503 of 2019 titled as Lal Chand vs. Kakka @ Vinod Kumar and another, expeditiously preferably within time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently contended that ROR filed by the petitioner alongwith the stay application is pending since the year 2019 and now the warrants of possession have been issued on 29.08.2023, however, the same has not even been taken up for hearing. He has submitted that due to the pendency of the same, the petitioners are suffering irreparable loss.

Ms. Akshita Chauhan, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Financial Commissioner (Revenue) to hear and decide the ROR alongwith the stay application expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within three months from today. The warrants of possession as issued would remain stayed till the decision of the stay application filed by the petitioner alongwith ROR.
