Prayer in the instant application is for disposal of the main case on the ground that matter has already been compromised between the parties.

Notice in the application.

Mr. L.S. Sidhu, Advocate, for respondent No.2 who is present in Court accepts notice.

In the light of the averments made in the application which are duly supported by an affidavit and by recording a 'no objection' from the counsel opposite, prayer is allowed. Main case is taken up on board today itself.

Application stands disposed of.

Main case

Learned counsel for the parties submitted that they have already compromised their dispute vide compromise deed dated 21.01.2023. Copy of which has been appended as Annexure A-1. Hence, the present regular second appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further but with the direction to the respondents also to adhere to the said compromise.

Mr. L.S. Sidhu, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2-Surjeet Kaur, submits that the parties have already compromised the matter and the parties intend to comply with the terms and conditions of the said compromise, without fail.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 that the parties have compromised the matter, the present appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the parties to avail of the benefit under the compromise.

Learned counsel for the appellant further submits that as the benefit admissible to the parties in respect of the service rendered by Gurcharan Singh has not been released by the PRTC so far, the PRTC may kindly be directed to release the said benefit in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present appeal is disposed of as having been not pressed any further with the observation that in case the PRTC-respondent No.1 has not released the benefit in favour the person who is entitled for, the same be released, within a period of two months from today in accordance with law.
