1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr. PC with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, at the hands of private respondents.
2. In pursuant to the notice, a reply by way of an affidavit of Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur has been filed.
3. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner as well as the respondents No.4 to 6 were associated in an enquiry and their statements were recorded. During the enquiry of the local police, it has been found that there is no threat to the petitioner and his friends from respondents No.4 to 6, at this stage. However, appropriate directions have already been issued to the concerned SHO to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his friends. Learned State counsel has further assured the Court that in case any

representation is received with regard to the protection of his life and liberty,
necessary action shall be taken in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further
directions are required and the petition is ordered to be disposed off,
accordingly.
