By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 5 to take appropriate action in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.92 dated 29.06.2022, registered at Police Station Women Jhajjar, District Jhajjar, under Sections 6, 12, 17 of the POCSO Act and Sections 323, 376(2) & 120-B of IPC.

Mr. Apoorv Garg, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from SI Neelam from the afore-referred Police Station, he informs the Court that the Polygraphy Test and the Layered Voice Analysis Examination (LVA) of the accused were conducted on 05.07.2023 and 07.07.2023 respectively and the Reports in respect of both these Tests had been prepared by the concerned Forensic

Science Laboratory on 23.08.2023 which had been received by the Investigating Agency on 25.09.2023 and the investigation proceedings are being conducted by the Special Investigating Team as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the above-discussed submissions as made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage.

Learned State counsel has no objection for the same.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
