The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.119 dated 11.08.2023 registered under Sections 379, 420 of IPC and Section 21(1), 4(1) of Mines and Mineral (Regulation of Development) Act, 1957, at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 03.10.2023, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
