The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking quashing of the notice dated 16.09.2022 (Annexure P-8) which has been issued by Economic Offences Wing-1, Nuh (wrongly mentioned as respondent No.2-DGP, Haryana).

Short reply by way of affidavit of Usha, HPS, Additional Superintendent of Police, Nuh has been filed wherein it has been averred that the complaint submitted by respondent No.7 has already been inquired into and the matter was found to be civil in nature. Thus, no action was proposed to be taken on the part of the police. It has been ordered to file the said complaint.

The complaint in question was also filed by the Superintendent of Police, Nuh on 24.03.2023.

of as having been rendered infructuous.
