The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.31 dated 31.03.2022 under Sections 307/379B/323/324/427/452/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 325/201 IPC (added later on) registered with Police Station Tarsikka, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 11.11.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A short reply dated 15.02.2023 has been placed on record by the learned counsel for the State. He, on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 11.11.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 11.11.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
