The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been invoked for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 134, dated 24.08.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Section 307 IPC added later on vide DDR No. 20, dated 22.06.2022) registered at Police Station City-I, Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation

qua the petitioner is that he gave a stick blow on the right temple of the complainant and later on the injury attributed to the petitioner has been declared simple in nature.

Custody certificate of the petitioner as well as status report dated 12.01.2023 filed by way of an affidavit of Mr. Sanjeev Goyal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Mansa filed by learned State counsel are taken on record. According to custody certificate the petitioner has suffered incarceration for a period of 7 months and 22 days and he is not involved in any other case of any nature.

Considering the afore-said facts and circumstances and the period so far undergone by the petitioner i.e. 7 months and 22 days added with the facts that the injury attributed to the petitioner has been declared simple in nature; he is not involved in any other case and conclusion of trial will take sufficient long time, this Court is of the considered view that no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The present petition stands allowed in view of the afore-said terms.
