The instant writ petition has been preferred raising a challenge to the Pre-Sale Notice dated 29.10.2022 (Annexure P-4), whereby respondent-Finance Company was wanting to sell the vehicle make Tata SFC 709 EX bearing Registration No.PB-13-BE-6073 after taking possession thereof.

Pursuant to the interim order dated 16.03.2023 passed by this Court the parties have appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. The dispute has been amicably resolved and a report in this regard has also been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court along with settlement agreement dated 01.05.2023.

The parties do not dispute that the settlement in question has been arrived at between them with their own free will and volition and without any coercion, undue influence or pressure from any quarter.

It is further pointed out by the learned counsel for the petitioner that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.11.2022 passed by this Court, the amount of Rs.1 lakh deposited by the petitioner with the Registry of this Court vide Receipt No.9917 dated 12.12.2022 may be released to him.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents have no objection to the same.

Accordingly, in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The amount of Rs.1 lakh deposited by the petitioner vide Receipt No.9917 dated 12.12.2022 in compliance to the order dated 14.11.2022 passed by this Court is ordered to be released in favour of the petitioner.
