JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 04.10.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ *The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 04.09.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Judge Special Court, Ludhiana in FIR No.208 dated 11.08.2021 registered under Section 21B of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Focal Point, District Ludhiana whereby a bail order of the petitioner has been cancelled and his bail bonds and surety bonds have been forfeited to the State.*

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of noting down of an incorrect date, the petitioner was unable to appear on one date i.e. 04.09.2023 because of which the impugned order came to be passed. He states that he is ready and willing to join proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 07.11.2023.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.50,000/- as costs with the Chandi Kusht

Ashram Society, Shiv Ram Mandir (Leprosy Colony), Sector 47, Opp. 3 BRD Gate, Chandigarh and on his doing he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court. ”

On 07.11.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ CRM-45688-2023

This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of permission to place on record the copy of receipt dated 25.10.2023 as Annexure A-1. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and Annexure A-1 is taken on record.

CRM-45691-2023

This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of further time to the petitioner to surrender before the Trial Court in compliance to the order dated 04.10.2023 passed by this Hon'ble Court.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a week from the date of receipt of copy of the order in terms of order dated 04.10.2023.

CRM stands disposed of.

CRM-M-50024-2023

Adjourned to 08.12.2023.”

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the aforementioned orders the petitioner has surrendered and has since been granted the concession of interim bail vide order dated 09.11.2023. He has also deposited the cost of Rs.50,000/- imposed by this Court vide order dated 04.10.2023.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to

appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent himself without any sufficient cause.
