Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the earlier counsel has been elevated to the Bench. On a query raised by this Court, it was stated that the earlier counsel was Justice Alka Sarin (as her Lordship then was). It is a matter of grave concern that such requests are being made years after the elevation of the previous counsel. Learned counsel had appeared before this Court on the last date of hearing also when an application for preponement was listed. However, today also a request for an adjournment has been made on a frivolous ground. When confronted, it has been stated that arguing counsel is unwell. It is clear that the appellant is not interested in pursuing the case and is interested in only seeking adjournments. There is no occasion for this Court to adjourn the case when such misrepresentations are being made.
