As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of **Rs. 3,00,000/- (Three Lakhs only)** over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statements of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellants as per the award of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit the crossed-cheque for **Rs. 3,00,000/- (Three Lakhs only)** in the name of the appellants as per their respective shares with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of 45 days, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant counsel/appellant

may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat. The above said amount be disbursed as per the shares mentioned in the Award passed by the concerned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. The shares of the minor children be kept in the shape of FDR in a Nationalized Bank fetching maximum interest till they attain the age of majority and the amount due on the maturity of the FDRs should be paid to the claimants directly by the concerned Bank without the intervention of the Court.

All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
