The grievance of the petitioner primarily is that the petitioner has not been granted the benefit, which accrues to him on the basis of the judgment and decree dated 25.02.2019, which has been passed in favour of the mother of the petitioner, who had executed a registered Will dated 02.03.2016 in his favour. The matter with regard to the said claim is pending consideration before the respondents and even notice dated 03.08.2022 (Annexure P-5) through counsel as addressed to the respondents has not been responded to till date.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the legal notice, as referred to above, shall be considered and a decision taken thereon within a period of six weeks from today.
