Learned counsel for the petitioner/plaintiff submits that the ex-parte ad-interim injunction order was passed in favour of the petitioner by the learned trial Court on 23.07.2021 (Annexure P-2) and thereafter, the respondents time and again made attempts to violate the said ad-interim injunction order by breaking open the locks of the tubewell room and the petitioner filed an application for police help for implementation of the aforesaid ad-interim injunction order and the copy of the said application is Annexure P-3, but the learned trial Court failed to pass any appropriate order in the said application and adjourned the same from time to time and now the next date fixed in the said application is 20.10.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, if necessary directions are given to the

learned trial Court, to decide the said application (Annexure P-3) in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

In the light of the above, the present petition is hereby disposed of, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, with the directions to the learned trial Court to consider the application (Annexure P-3), which has been moved by the petitioner seeking police help, on the next date fixed i.e 20.10.2023 or within next 10 days thereafter, in accordance with law and to pass appropriate order in the said application.
