The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.136 dated 14.09.2022 registered under Section 61 of the Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwant Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.11.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
