This is an application filed under Section 151 Civil Procedure Code for placing on record Proceedings of the meetings dated 04.10.2023, 09.10.2023, 16.10.2023, 19.10.2023 and 01.11.2023, held between the Management and petitioner-Union as Annexure P-11 to Annexure P-15.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and Proceedings of the meetings dated 04.10.2023, 09.10.2023, 16.10.2023, 19.10.2023 and 01.11.2023, held between the Management and petitioner-Union (Annexure P-11 to Annexure P-15) are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

Application is accordingly disposed of.

CWP-22335-2023

The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to take appropriate action on the demand notice

dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P-3), served by petitioner under Section 2(k) of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

It appears that no reconciliation took place.

At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner submits that he confines his prayer only qua limited relief that appropriate directions be issued to respondents No. 3 and 4 (Labour Commissioner, Punjab and Assistant Labour Commissioner, Punjab respectively) to take appropriate action on the demand notice dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P-3), served by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

In my considered, the prayer made by the petitioner is genuine and learned counsel appearing for respondents No. 6 to 8 also does not raise any serious dispute on the same.

Accordingly, the instant writ petition is disposed of with directions to respondents No. 3 and 4 (Labour Commissioner, Punjab and Assistant Labour Commissioner, Punjab respectively) to take appropriate necessary action on the demand notice dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P-3), served by petitioner, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt/production of certified copy of this order.

All pending application (s), if any, shall stand closed.
