The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the claim of the petitioners is squarely covered by the judgments passed by this Court in **CWP-24394-2011** dated 09.05.2012 (Annexure P-2) and **CWP-2828-2016** and other connected case dated 27.07.2018 (Annexure P-11) and **CWP-3628-2018** dated 01.05.2023 (Annexure P-14)

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present writ petition be disposed of in terms of judgment passed by this Court in **CWP No.3628 of 2018**, whereby Bunch of writ petition have been decided on 01.05.2023 (Annexure P-14) wherein respondents were directed to reconsider the case of the similarly situated employees and the respondents were granted time till 31.12.2023. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that petitioners

would be satisfied if the prayer made in the writ petition be disposed of in terms of aforesaid judgment dated 01.05.2023 (Annexure P-14).

Mr. Arun Gupta, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 and submits that he does not object to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in terms of aforesaid judgment dated 01.05.2023 (Annexure P-14).
