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1. *Counsel appearing for the appellant submits that parties to the lis have resolved their dispute by way of compromise-deed dated 08.04.2021, and in support of his submissions, he produced a photocopy of said compromise-deed in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Office to tag the same at appropriate place.*

2. *Counsel for the appellant requests for recommending the present appeal to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Counsel appearing for the respondent pleads no objection to the request of counsel for the appellant.*

3. *Keeping in view the factum of compromise and in view of the request made by counsel for the parties, the matter is referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Parties are directed to remain present before the said Forum on 20.07.2023, or any other date fixed by it.*

4. *For awaiting report, adjourned to 13.10.2023.”*

2. Thereupon, parties appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, and as per report dated 11.10.2023, received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, parties have settled their dispute by way of amicable settlement/agreement, which is placed on the case file.

Thus, the dispute between the parties has been finally settled by executing a settlement/compromise dated 11.10.2023, before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. Said settlement/compromise is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Office to tag the same at appropriate place in the case file.
