The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 23.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the JMIC, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri in Complaint No.NIA/2181/2016 dated 08.12.2016 vide which the petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person as well as the consequential proceedings arising therefrom including FIR No.446 dated 15.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station City Jagadhri.

On 16.10.2023, the following order was passed:-

“Notice of motion.

On advance service of copy of petition, learned State counsel appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State of Haryana and seeks time to file reply.

Adjourned to 19.12.2023.

Meanwhile, petitioner to appear before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks and on his causing appearance, he shall be admitted to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Court below.”

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Based on the aforementioned order, the petitioner has surrendered and has since been released on interim bail. The copy of the order dated 03.11.2023 passed by the ACJM, Jagadhri is marked as X.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
