Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that despite there being a Policy Decision dated 09.02.2015 (Annexure P-4) regulating the Paying Guest Accommodation in the Residential Area of SAS Nagar, Mohali, the same is not being given effect to.

Notice through counsel has been served upon the respondents on 01.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) but still, no action, in pursuance thereto, till date has been taken.

On hearing the counsel for the petitioner, we are of the view that the policy has already been issued by the competent authority dated 09.02.2015 (Annexure P-4) regulating the Paying Guest Accommodation in the Residential Area of SAS Nagar, Mohali and, therefore, it is the implementation thereof, which is lacking.

It would, therefore, be open to the petitioner to move

appropriate application/representation to the competent authority, which would include the Estate Officer, GMADA as well as the Deputy Commissioner, Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali and the Station House Officer of the concerned area.

If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and a decision taken thereon within a period of six weeks of submission of such representation. Decision, so taken, be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
