This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to replace old bus with vehicle No.PB-05C-9909 on permit No.1205/Reg/RTA/F/FZR/2003 on Makhu to Mallawala via Sadhara Butterwala route.

2. Learned State Counsel, on instructions from Neeraj Kumar, Junior Assistant, RTA Ferozepur, has submitted that in the present case, transfer as prayed for by the petitioner has been effected and thus, the prayer made by the petitioner has been granted.
