Prayer in the present application is for impleading (i) Onkar son of Ghisu resident of Village Maheswari, Tehsil Daruhera, District Rewari, (ii) Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate, Rewari, (iii) Sub Divisional Magistrate, Rewari and (iv) Naib Tehsildar Dharuhera, District Rewari as party respondents No.11 to 14 in the present petition and for placing on record the amended memo of parties.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the above-mentioned applicants are impleaded as respondents in the present petition.

Application is allowed. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

Main case

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of direction to the official respondents to restore the possession of the property in dispute which has been taken over illegally and arbitrary by

the private respondents to the Naib Tehsildar-cum-Receiver appointed by learned Sub Divisional Magistrate by taking it back from the private respondents. Further prayer has been made directing the Sub Divisional Magistrate and Naib Tehsildar-cum-Receiver to pay costs, damages and compensation for illegally and arbitrarily allowing the private respondents to continue in possession of the disputed property inspite of the appointment of a receiver.

Learned State counsel has stated that in case the petitioner files representation before newly added respondent i.e. Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate Rewari then he will decide the same as per law.

Heard. After hearing the counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation for redressal of his grievance to the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate Rewari within seven days from today. If he files any such representation, then the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Magistrate Rewari would deal with and decide the same within four weeks thereafter from the date of filing of the representation.
