Prayer in this contempt petition is for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondents for non-compliance of order dated 15.07.2019, vide which the ***CWP No. 19471 of 2018***, filed by the petitioner, was disposed of in terms of order dated 19.05.2018 passed in another ***CWP No. 2202 of 2016***.

A perusal of the order dated 19.05.2018 passed in the aforesaid writ petitions shows that the impugned order dated 24.11.2015 was quashed and a direction was issued to consider the case of the petitioners therein for regularization w.e.f. the date when their juniors were brought on regular cadre as per policy and to grant them the same relief with all consequential benefits flowing therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 25.03.2022, the services of the petitioner have been regularized, however, as per instructions of the Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, dated 21.12.2018, the arrears have been paid only for 38 months, prior to the date of joining.

Since there is no challenge to the instructions dated 21.12.2018 in both the aforesaid writ petitions, as per which the arrears have been paid to the petitioner, no case of willful disobedience is made out against the respondents.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
