Prayer herein is to refer the matter to Mediation Centre to explore the possibility of mutual settlement. It transpires that during the interregnum of filing the appeal, parties have settled the matter amicably. Pursuant thereto, a compromise deed dated 15.09.2019 (Annexure A-1) has already been executed.

In the premise, no useful purpose would be served to refer the matter to mediator. However, in view of the averments contained in the application *qua* the compromise, main case, which is otherwise slated for hearing on 17.07.2023, is taken up on Board for hearing today itself.

Main appeal

Matter since has already been settled between the parties by compromise deed dated 15.09.2019 (Annexure A-1), instant appeal is rendered infructuous. Disposed of, accordingly.

Parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise. Since the matter has been mutually settled, the judgments and decrees rendered by learned Courts below are rendered nullity and the terms of the compromise deed shall supersede the same.
