1. These are two petitions filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 63 dated 01.05.2014 registered under Sections 323/324/325/326/452/201/148/149 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kurali, District Mohali and cross case bearing DDR No. 29 dated 02.05.2014 registered under Sections 323/324/325/326/452/201/148/149 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Kurali, District Mohali (in aforesaid FIR) on the basis of compromise.

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CRM-M-53900-2022, at the outset, informs the Court that the compromise between the parties has failed and she objects to the quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

3. Learned State counsel submits that both the parties are closely related to each other and the parties have already appeared before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate in compliance of the order passed by this Court and statements in support of the compromise has already been recorded.

4. At this stage, both the counsel for the petitioners wish to withdraw the present petitions with liberty to file the fresh petitions.

5. In view of the objection made by learned counsel for respondent No. 6 in CRM-M-53900-2022, both the petitions are dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh petitions seeking quashing of FIR/DDR in question, on the basis of compromise, if effected between the parties, in future.
