1. Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing/setting aside the order dated 05.06.2023 (Annexure P-2) and order dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) whereby the petitioner has been rusticated from respondent No.4-University.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that against the order dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure P-3), the petitioner had filed an appeal and in the said appeal although personal hearing has been given to the petitioner, but no final order has been communicated to him. It is submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied, at this stage, in case respondent No.5 is directed to decide the said appeal and convey the order passed in the appeal to the petitioner, in accordance with law,

within a specific time frame.

3. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to decide the appeal filed by the petitioner against the order dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) and to communicate the order regarding the same to the petitioner, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.5 would consider and decide the matter independently, in accordance with law.
