AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0246 dated 17.12.2021, under Section 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Division 6, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 14.11.2022 of this Court, the petitioner has not only joined investigation on 24.11.2022 but has also fully cooperated with the investigating agency. He further submits that in case the investigating agency requires the petitioner to appear, he shall make himself available without demur. He further submits that petitioner has also filed a petition bearing CRM-M-57338-2022 for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise before this Court, wherein direction for recording of statements before the trial Court has been issued.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Baljit affirms the factum of joining the investigation by the petitioner and cooperating with the investigation agency. He also submits that at this stage, the petitioner is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner is allowed and the order dated 14.11.2022 granting interim bail to him, is hereby made absolute, subject to compliance of conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C

However, it is made clear that if the petitioner fails to join and cooperate with the investigation agency as and when required, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of the present anticipatory bail granted to him.
