Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing FIR No.156 dated 29.11.2016 registered at Police Station Sector 20, Panchkula under Section 4 of the Money Laundering Act read with Section 420, 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn attention of this Court towards order dated 11.03.2022 passed by this Court in CRM-M-10219 of 2017 whereby similar petition filed by co-accused Navrattan Garg and Ashwani Sharma has already been quashed.

The afore-said factual position is conceded by learned State Counsel and is also so mentioned in the reply by way of affidavit of Shri Kishori Lal, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula filed on behalf of the respondent- State.

For all the reasons as mentioned in the order dated 11.03.2022 in CRM-M-10219 of 2017, proceedings of the FIR in question and all the subsequent proceedings qua petitioner also stand quashed.
