This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the petitioners' fundamental rights. A prayer has also been made to issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.1 to dispose of the appeal dated 12.2.2019 (Annexure P-6) filed under Rule 158B of the Haryana School Education Rules by passing a speaking order.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that he is limiting the relief claimed in the present petition only to the extent of directing respondent no.1 to dispose of the appeal dated 12.2.2019 (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated time frame.

3. Learned State Counsel has submitted that respondent No.1 would decide the appeal dated 12.2.2019 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of two

months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

4. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.1 to decide the the appeal dated 12.2.2019 (Annexure P-6), in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

5. This Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.1 would consider the appeal filed by the petitioners independently and in accordance with law.
