The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 124 dated 22.10.2022 registered under Sections 21, 29, 61 and 85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Khuian Sarwar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, in compliance of order dated 15.11.2022, filed status report by way of affidavit of Gurmeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, CAW Fazilka, Addl. Charge Sub Division Abohar, District Fazilka, same is taken on record and on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 15.11.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
