Prayer in this Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if direction is issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali, to consider and take a final decision on representations dated 24.08.2023 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) made by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Shubham Kaushik, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4 and submits that he has no objection in case the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage, is accepted.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without going

into the merits of the present petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3- Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali, to forthwith consider the grievance(s) raised by the petitioner in the aforesaid representations and take action thereupon as he deems fit, in accordance with law, within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
