On 05.10.2023, the following order was passed:-

Learned counsel contends that the name of the petitioner has surfaced based on disclosure statements of co-accused-Dhruv Sangwan, as per which he was present alongwith him at the time of alleged occurrence. The said co-accused has been granted bail by the trial Court vide order dated 19.09.2023. The matter stands compromised between the parties, affidavit of the complainant in this regard annexed as Annexure P-3. The petitioner is not

involved in any other case and is ready and willing to join the investigation as and when required by the investigating agency and will cooperate.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Jagdish Manchanda, Addl.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Adjourned to 18.11.2023.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation on or before 30.10.2023. In the even of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to compliance of conditions as enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C/

However, it is clarified that if the petitioner does not join and cooperate with the Investigating Agency as required by the Arresting/Investigating Officer, this interim order shall be deemed to have been vacated.'

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sanjay Kumar, at the very outset informs the Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, order dated 05.10.2023 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
