The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.236 dated 23.06.2021 under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471 474, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Kharar, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that all the necessary original documents are on the record of the civil suit bearing No.CS-274-2021 instituted in the Court of Civil Judge (Jr. Division), Kharar. He further contends that the petitioner has not only joined investigation pursuant to the interim order dated 06.10.2023 passed by this Court, but a compromise has also been arrived at between the parties.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 06.10.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 06.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
