1. Present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner claiming the medical reimbursement to the tune of Rs.16,08,536/-.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had incurred a sum of Rs.23,97,449/- while she suffered ailment during the pandemic of Covid-19 being on duty as a Medical Officer but out of the said amount, a sum of Rs.7,88,913/- has only been reimbursed to the petitioner and remaining amount has not been reimbursed so far. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the respondents may kindly be directed to reimburse the total medical expenses to the petitioner which she has incurred on her medical treatment.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present writ petition has already been raised by the petitioner

through a representation dated 17.01.2023, a copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-11, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-11) is still pending with the authorities concerned, appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case after the passing of the speaking order, any amount is liable to be paid to the petitioner, the same will be paid to her within a further period of four weeks.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
